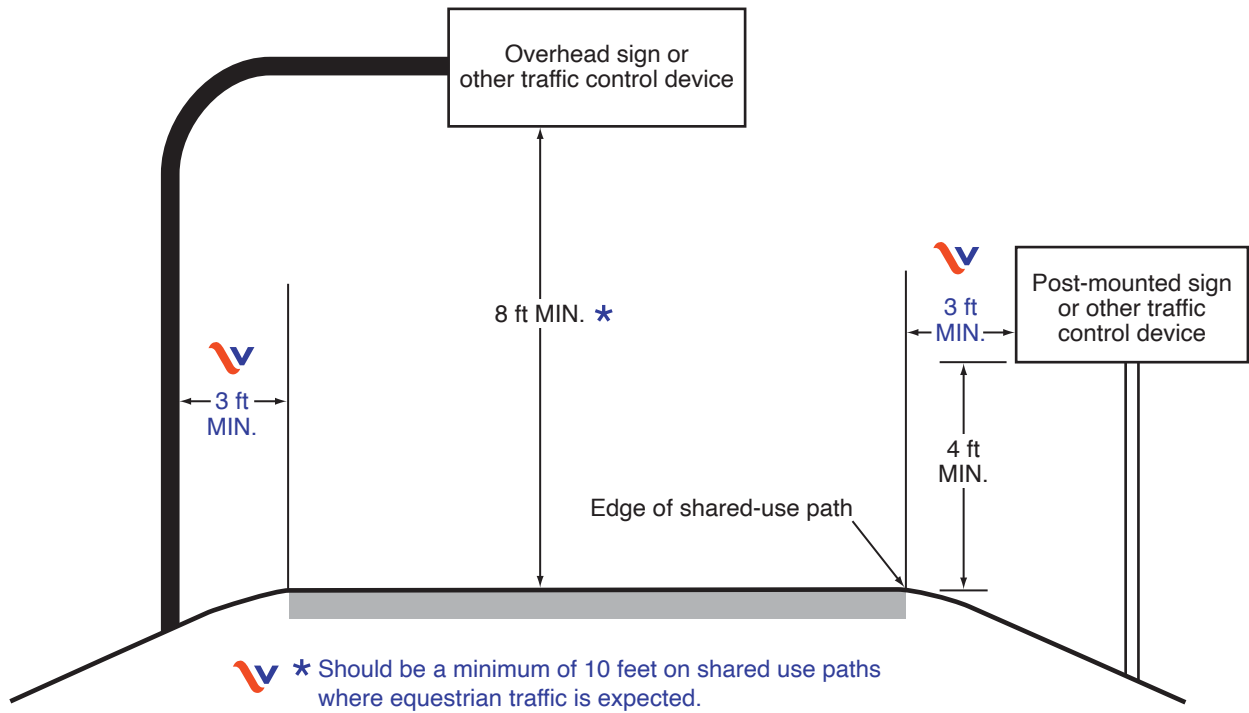
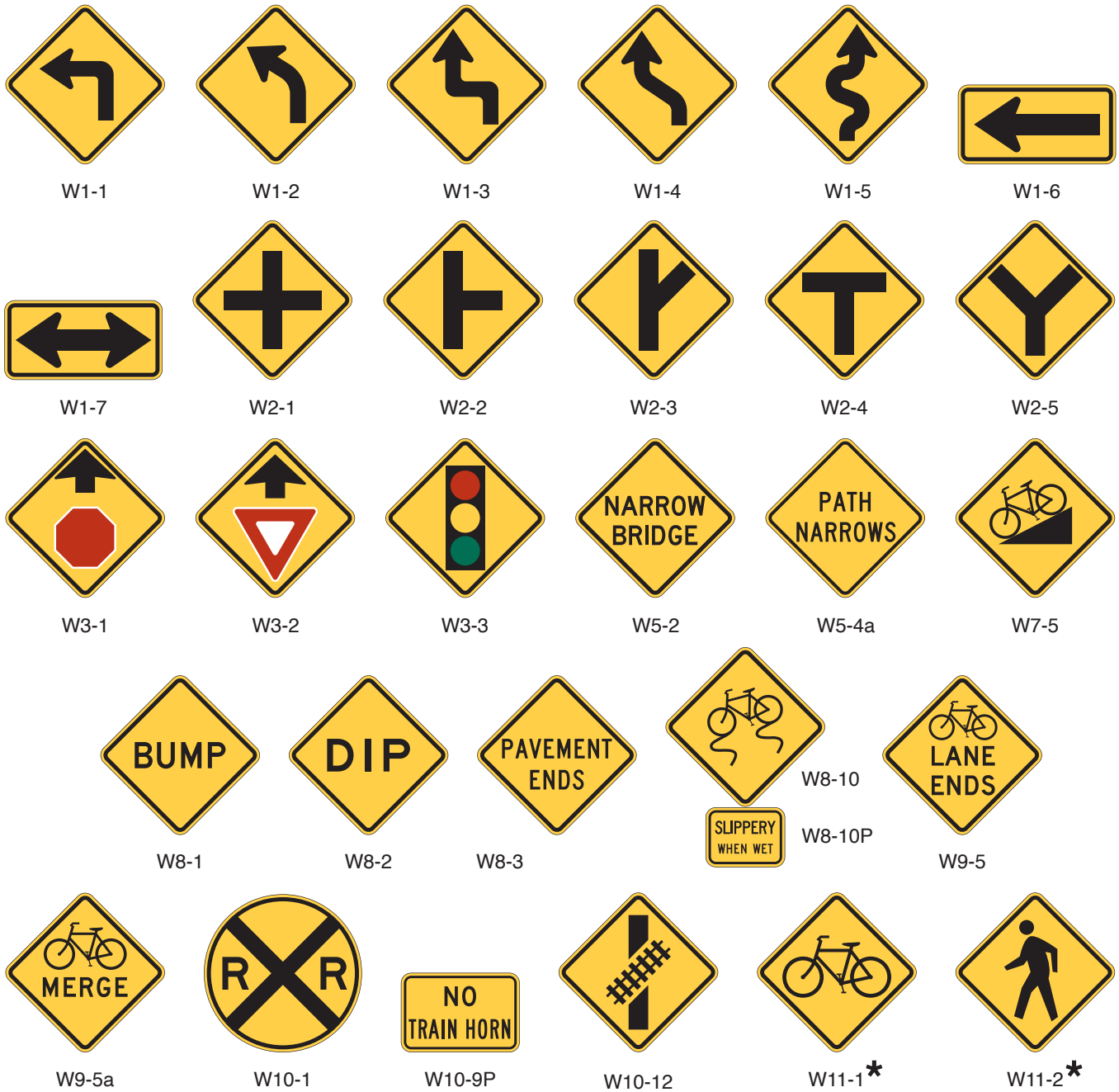


Figure 9A-1(VA). Sign Placement on Shared-Use Paths

for Bicycle Facilities (Sheet 1 of 2)**




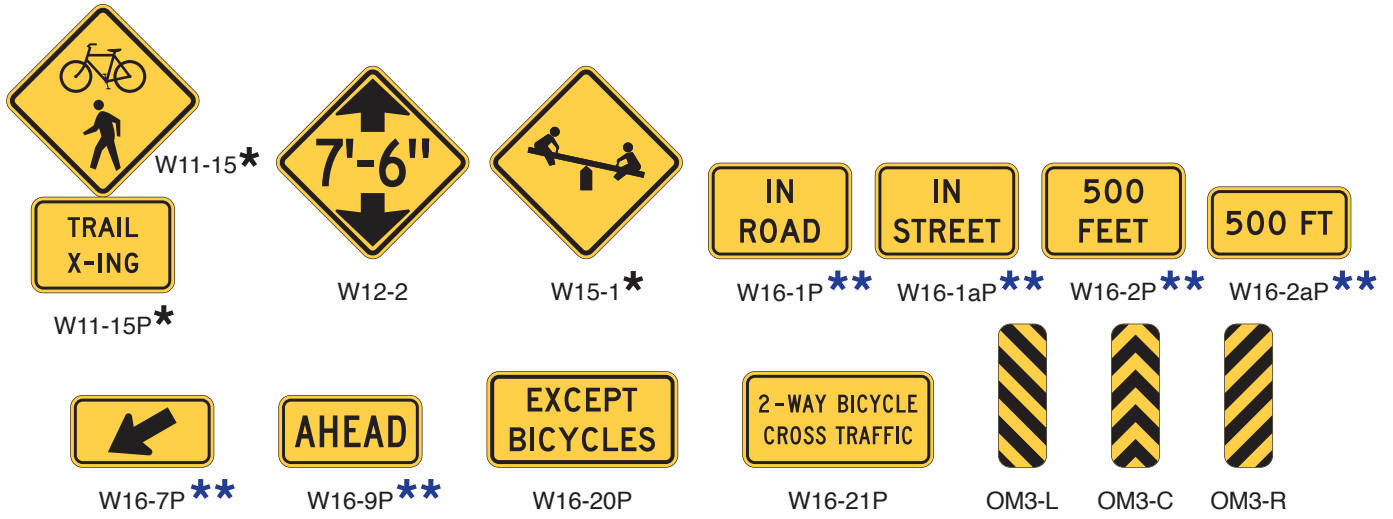

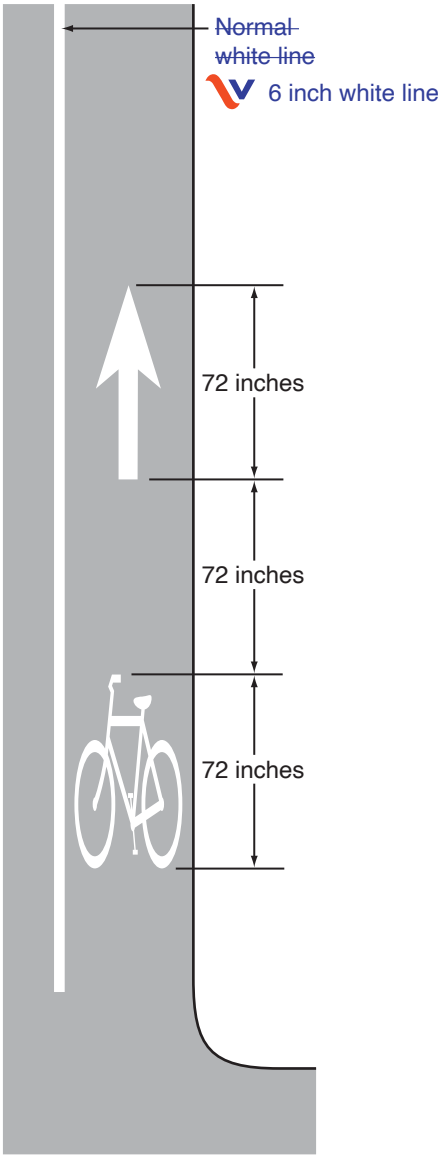

B – Word legends

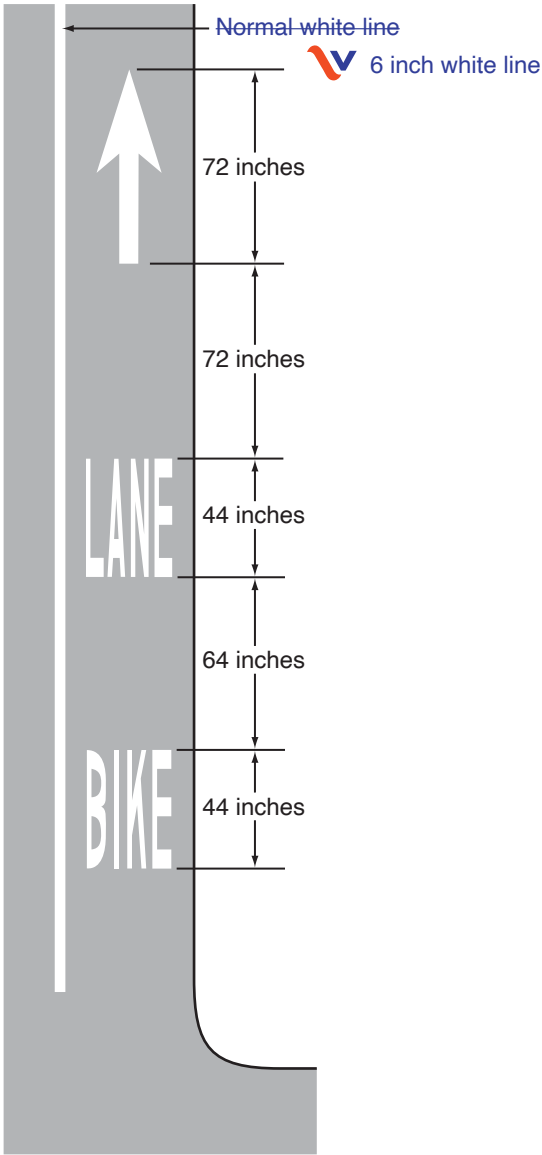


Figure 9E-2(VA). Example of Pavement Markings for Bicycle Lanes on a Two-Way Street

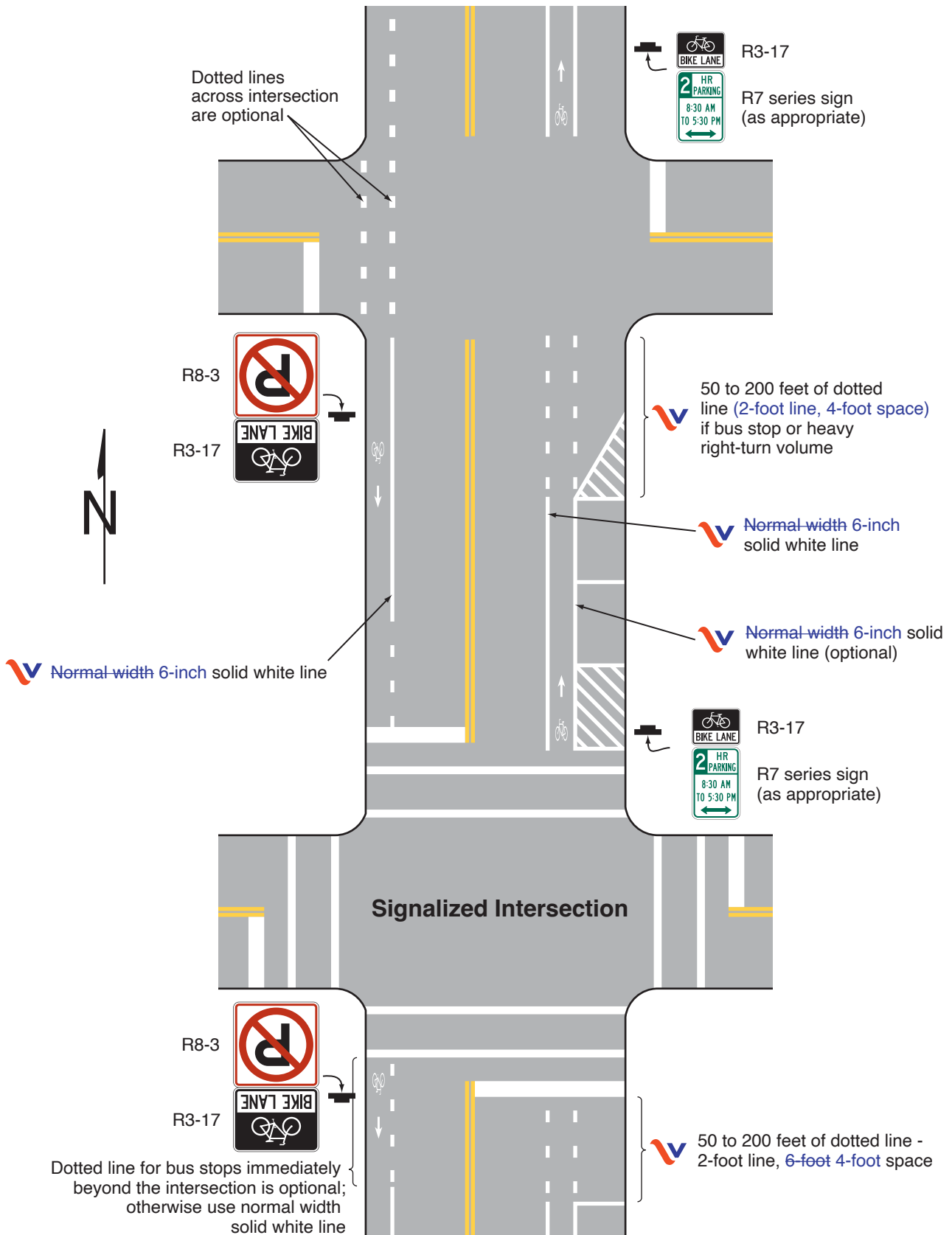


Figure 9E-3(VA). Examples of Bicycle Lane Markings on an Approach to an Intersection
(Sheet 1 of 3)

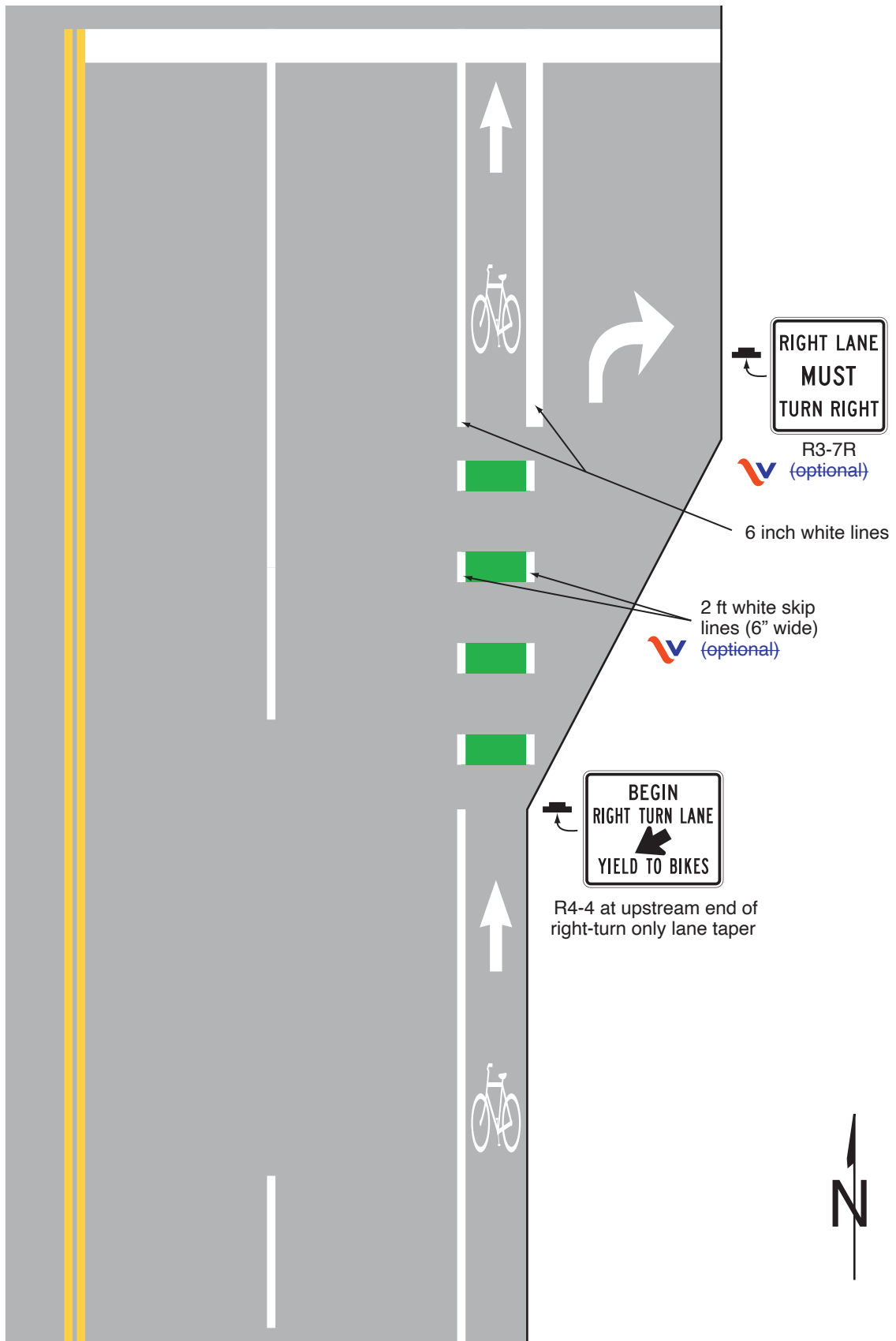


Figure 9E-3(VA). Examples of Bicycle Lane Markings on an Approach to an Intersection
(Sheet 3 of 3)

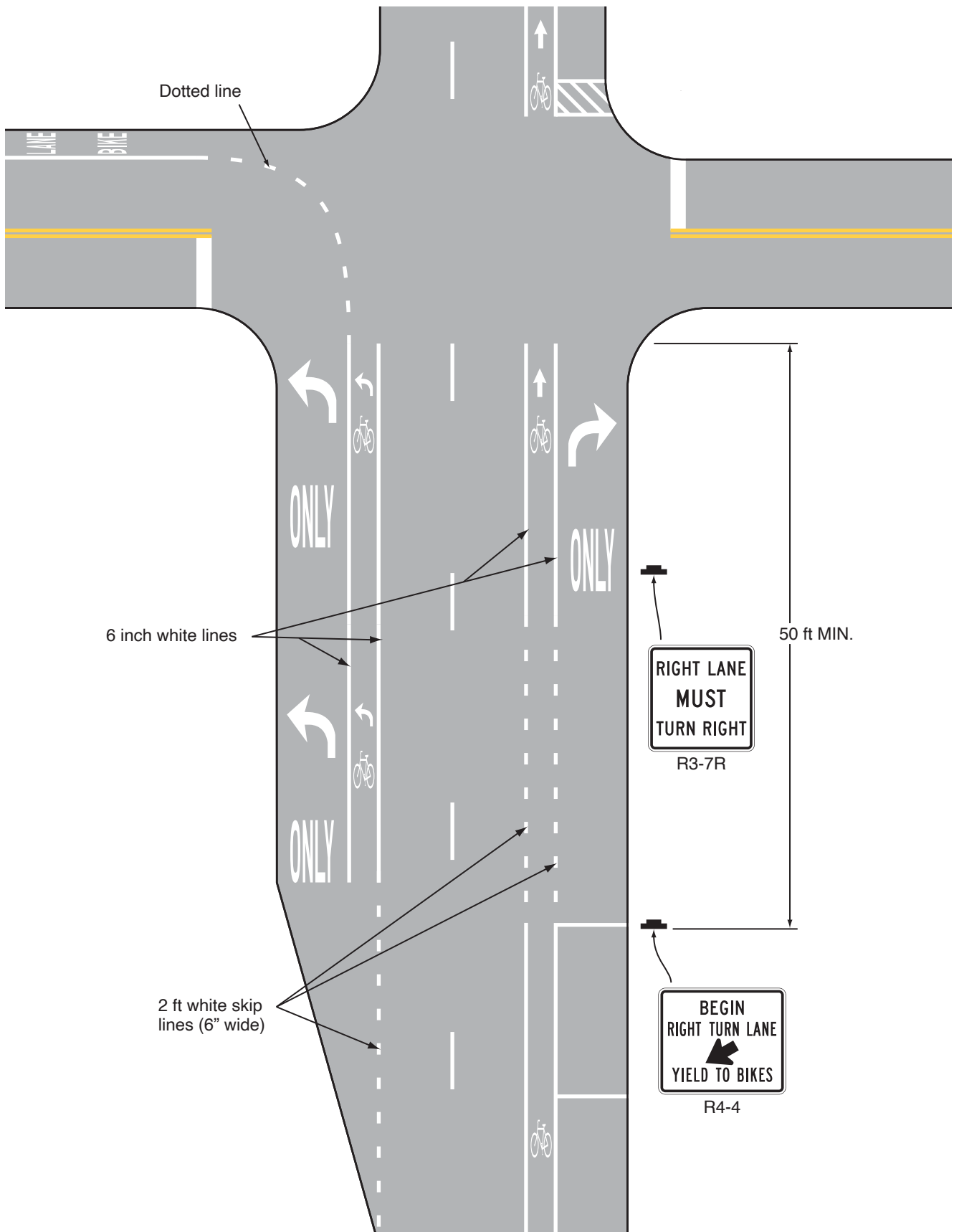


Figure 9E-4(VA). Example of Bicycle Lane Markings on an Approach to an Intersection that Transitions from a Shared Lane
